AND INITIAL PROCEDURAL **SCHEDULE** On August 18, 2017, Havre Pipeline Company ("HPC") filed its Proposed Special Terms and Conditions for Schedule No. 1 Natural Gas Tariff for its Farm Tap Service ("Proposal") with the Montana **Public Service Commission** ("Commission" or "PSC"). This filing is in response to Final Order 7514b in this docket, hich required HPC to mak the appropriate modifications to its tariff. In its Proposal subject to Commission approval, see Mont Code Ann. § 69-3-302 (2017), HPC requests the following terms: HPC shall have access to the customer's premises "at all times" in "the exercise of any and all rights secured to it by law or these terms and conditions" (Proposal § 2-1); HPC's service to customers will be "subject to Supply and Capacity Shortages" and "volume and pressure will be limited by the meter" (id. § 3-1); HPC will not "guarantee continuous gas service" and HPC will "not be liable to [customers] or others for failure or interruption of gas service" due to certain events (id. § 3-2); HPC may interrupt service to customers for repairs and changes (id. § 3-3); HPC may limit its response to service calls to its normal business hours of Monday-Friday from 7:00 am to 2:00 pm (id. § 3-4); A defined division of equipment owned by HPC and customers (id. § 4-1); Customers are responsible for installation and maintenance of customer owned equipment (id. § 4-2); If HPC identifies an unsafe condition on the customer's facilities, it may discontinue service until the unsafe condition is repaired by the customer (id. § 4-3);

definitions (id. §§ 1-1 to 1-8). A copy of the filing is available for inspection at the Commission's business offices, 1701 Prospect Avenue, P.O. Box 202601, Helena, Montana 59620-2601; and the Montana Consumer Counsel (MCC), 111 North Last Chance Gulch Suite 1B, P.O. Box 201703, Helena, Montana 59620-1703, telephone (406) 444-2771. The MCC is available to represent the interests of the consuming public in this matter.

General terms for metering

Any interested person who is directly affected by HPC's filing before the Commission and who wants to be a party to the docket must file a petition to intervene with the Commission no later than September 29, 2017. A petition seeking general intervention must disclose the name and

address of the party intervening; the name and address of the petitioner's attorney, if any; a clear and concise statement of the direct and substantial interest of the petitioner in the proceeding; the petitioner's position in regard to the matter in controversy; and a statement of the relief desired. By the intervention deadline, a person petitioning for intervention must: (1) Submit the petition electronically (e-file) on the Commission's website at http:// psc.mt.gov ("Account Login/ Registration" under "Electronic Documents" tab); and (2) physically deliver or mail the original petition to the Commission at the address above. The Commission will not post an e-filed document to its website until it receives the original from the petitioner. A person petitioning for intervention in this Docket must also serve a hard copy of the petition on the MCC and HPC's counsel, Sarah Norcott, NorthWestern Energy, 208 N. The PSC and any party may submit preliminary data requests to HPC. HPC must respond to preliminary data reguests within twenty-one (21) days of the service date of the data requests. If an initial data request is objectionable or seeks confidential information. HPC must respond accordingly a motion for protective order no later than the deadline to respond; if necessary, HPC must file an updated response within fourteen (14) days of the PSC ruling on the objection or motion for protective order.


