It is the intent of FBCEDC to enter into a contract with the selected contractors which include a fixed fee and a guaranteed maximum price (GMP) for each subsection of the scope of the work.

The scope of work will include all necessary components/items for the complete and satisfactory hauling, placing, and the compaction of materials for a store parking lot.
