The United States Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS), in cooperation with the Fort Belknap Indian Community (Sponsor), will be preparing a Watershed Plan-Environmental Assessment (EA) for Lake Seventeen and Little Suction Creek and associated watersheds in Blaine and Phillips Counties. The watershed Plan-EA will be prepared under the NRCS Watershed and Flood Prevention Operations Program and will consider opportunities to conserve and improve habitat for fish and wildlife, public recreation, and agricultural water management in conjunction with Lake Seventeen, its dam, and diversion channel; Little Suction Creek; Duck Creek and/or Peoples Creek. It will include exploration of how to best use Tribal water rights and what opportunities exist to meet needs associated with those rights.
